Subject: Tuition Remission for Continuing

Studies and Special Programs

<u>Tuition Remission For Continuing Studies and Special Programs</u>

Community Art Programs – Fall, Spring, Summer classes & workshops
On a space-available basis, Regular Full-time staff employees are eligible for
Continuing Studies and Special Programs tuition remission for themselves, their
spouses, and their children (who meet the IRS definition of dependent). Tuition
remission covers 80% of the published cost of the class. The class cost includes fees
registration, lab and model fees. Certificate fees, supplies, transportation and housing
are not included and are the responsibility of the enrolling staff employee. Therefore,
staff employees and their qualified dependents will pay 20% of the published cost plus
applicable fees.

Regular Part-time staff employees are eligible for tuition remission for the employee. Dependents of Part-time staff employees are not eligible for tuition remission.

Staff with Casual appointments who are currently working are eligible for tuition remission for the employee. Dependents of Casual staff employees are not eligible for tuition remission.

Wildacres Program

Regular Full-time staff employees, their spouses, and their dependent children are eligible for tuition remission on the tuition portion only of the Wildacres Program on a space-available basis. Children under 15 years of age are not eligible for the program and may not reside in provided housing. Transportation and art supplies are the responsibility of the staff member. Regular Part-time staff employees are granted tuition remission for the employee. Dependents of Part-time staff employees are not eligible for tuition remission. Staff with Casual appointments are eligible for tuition remission for the employee. Dependents of staff with Casual appointments are not eligible for tuition remission.

Precollege Program

Eligible dependent children of Regular Full-time staff employees are eligible for tuition remission for the Precollege Program on a space-available basis. Eligible dependent children must apply and be accepted through the regular application procedure. Those accepted will be charged for any applicable fees, including food service, campus housing and supplies. Dependents of Part-time staff employees are not eligible for tuition remission. Dependents of staff with Casual appointments are not eligible for tuition remission.
